SUBJECT:

Registration and Facsimile Failures

A test laboratory recently made an unsuccessful, single attempt to register a test with the CMA Monitoring Agency. The laboratory started this test prior to registration. This is not an acceptable practice, and it is the test laboratory's responsibility to contact/telephone RSI if facsimile problems occur.

If the facsimile line used for test registration fails, laboratories must take the following actions in the order listed below:

- During office hours, call RSI staff and describe the problem.
- If an unsuccessful registration transmission occurs during non-business hours, or you are unable to reach RSI, transmit your registration on the RSI office facsimile line.
- In the unlikely event that both facsimile systems should fail during non-business hours, call any RSI phone line and leave a recorded message of the formulation/stand code that you are attempting to register. All RSI phone messages are time and day stamped, enabling RSI to verify that the facsimile systems were down.
