SUBJECT: Requests for Summary of Scheduled Tests

The CMA Monitoring Agency, upon sponsor request, generates a summary of all engine tests scheduled under a specific Sponsor ID and Sponsor Code.¹ If a test has not come to closure, a PENDING statement is generated for the fate of the test. This process is described in RSI Bulletin # R-017.

On many occasions, sponsoring companies need the summary only when all scheduled tests have closed.² RSI can "hold" the generation of the summary until all information are received from the laboratories if the sponsoring company's authorized requestor so indicates on the written sponsor request.

If no special instructions to hold are noted, RSI will continue to issue the summaries with all applicable PENDING statements upon receipt of the written request.
