**SUBJECT:** Retroactive Submission of Data for Heavy Duty Tests  
Summary of Scheduled Tests Generated by the CMA Monitoring Agency

The CMA Code of Practice now accommodates heavy duty tests. This bulletin describes a process to submit past data to the CMA Monitoring Agency and explains the pending inclusion of heavy duty test data within the summary of scheduled tests generated by the CMA Monitoring Agency. Please note there are two important dates within this bulletin: 1) the inclusion of heavy duty tests in the summary of scheduled tests, as defined in Appendix E Candidate Data Package, commences on April 30, 1994, and 2) the eligibility to submit data retroactively for heavy duty tests terminates on July 1, 1994.

#### SUMMARY OF SCHEDULED TESTS

The CMA Monitoring Agency, upon written sponsor request, generates a summary of all engine tests which were scheduled under the same Sponsor ID and Sponsor Code. RSI will include heavy duty tests in the summary commencing on April 30, 1994.

As described in the next section and in CMA Code Bulletin C-09, heavy duty test data that was generated before the implementation of registration for heavy duty tests must be submitted to RSI prior to July 1, 1994. If a summary of scheduled tests is issued by RSI prior to the July 1, 1994 cutoff date, it is a sponsoring company's responsibility to ensure retroactive data have been submitted and to request a new summary, if applicable. Heavy duty test data submitted retroactively will be identified in the summary.

#### RETROACTIVE SUBMISSION OF HEAVY DUTY TEST DATA

Results from Caterpillar 1M-PC, Caterpillar 1N, Mack T-8, GM 6.2L, and Detroit Diesel 6V92TA tests, which were run in ASTM calibrated test stands prior to required registration on March 30, 1994, must be submitted to the CMA Monitoring Agency if the tests are to be included in the Candidate Data Package.
