Subject: Reports-on-Demand for Annual Audit Lists

In the past, Test Sponsors and Test Laboratories have been able to request from RSI a list of all scheduled /registered tests for use during the annual audit process. This snail-mail (postal delivery) system is still available, but RSI has now added functionality to Data-InterchangeTM, which provides you with the means to download your 'audit list' upon demand. This new functionality, combining access to data summaries (detailed in RSI Bulletin #R-045) with access to audit lists, is called Reports On-Demand.

Individuals within the Test Sponsor community who have been authorized to access Data-Interchange (https://www.data-interchange.com) for downloading ACC Data Summaries now have immediate access to download their audit list. Your unique log-on and password remain the same.

The User's Manual for reports on Demand is located on RSI's ACC Monitoring Agency website at <u>http://www.registration-systems.com/Protected/welcome_DataInterchange.htm</u> (User name: acc / Password: rsi999). Individuals within each sponsoring company that need a password for Reports-on-Demand must contact Kim Herald by email (<u>kim.herald@registration-systems.com</u>) or telephone (1-210-341-2680, ext 200) to obtain access to the Reports-on Demand site.

Test Laboratories will need to provide Kim Herald with a list of authorized individuals. This list must come from the Lab Manager/Director or similar position of authority. Individuals can be granted two levels of authority, both of which can download audit lists:

- Level one: Authority to change the list.
- Level two: Authority to request an audit list or to download one.

Once an individual receives authorisation, the same procedures apply as for the Test Sponsors detailed above.
